- 1. Hearing taken up. Learned counsel Mr. Rishikesh Rajan appears on behalf of the Authority. Learned counsel Mr. Jai Ram Singh appears on behalf of the respondent.
- 2. Learned counsel for the respondent company admits that there has been a bona fide mistake on the part of the respondent for having allowed this kind of an advertisement. He further assures that nothing of this kind would happen again.
- 3. In view of candid confession of the respondent and the positive response, he is being let off with a minor penalty of Rs.50,000/- only. If the respondent fails to comply with the direction within 60 days, then the Authority would take further action u/s 36 and 63 of the RERA Act.
- 4. With this direction, the proceeding is dropped.
