Perused the record. The matter is filed for compensation as well as immediate possession of flat. The complainant admits that he is in possession.

In so far as the claim for compensation is concerned, the complainant is at liberty to approach the court of Adjudicating Officer.

The respondent is directed to complete the project and provide all the facilities as per Agreement to Sale within a period of two months failing which a penalty of Rs.1,000/-would be imposed for each day of delay.
