### **ORDER**

1. Hearing taken up. Both the parties are absent.
2. On the previous date i.e. on 14.08.2025, it was made clear that failure of parties to turn up on the next date of hearing would leave us with no option, but to proceed on the basis of the documents available on record.
3. This execution case has been filed for compliance of the order dated 24.09.2021/03.01.2022 passed in RERA/CC/357/2021, in which the Authority had directed the respondent company and its directors to refund the principal amount of Rs.16 lakh to the complainant/executant along with an interest at 2% above marginal cost of fund-based lending rate (MCLR) of the State Bank of India (as applicable) on the date on which the amount becomes due till the date of payment, within sixty days of issuance of order and respondent has failed to comply the directions of the Authority till date.
4. The complainant has reiterated his request for the execution of the order dated 24.09.2021/03.01.2022 passed in RERA/CC/357/2021.
5. Perused the record. The respondent has failed to file any reply or appear before the Authority despite several opportunities.

6. The Authority observes that despite knowledge of the order in the said complaint case, the respondent has neither complied with the order, nor has filed any reply, nor has appeared in the case. Hence, for expeditious justice, the Authority is compelled to pass an order for the recovery of the said amount, as the respondent cannot be allowed to prolong the matter indefinitely.
7. The Authority directs that in order to recover the amount mentioned in the order dated 24.09.2021/03.01.2022, a certificate of Public Demand Recovery be issued under Section 40(1) of the RERA Act, 2016, read with Rule 25 of the Bihar Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Rules, 2017, and Section 4/5 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demand Recovery Act, 1914.
8. A copy of the order be sent to the Collector, Patna, for recovery of the aforesaid amounts.

Accordingly, this matter stands disposed of.
