ORDER

- 1. Hearing taken up. Learned counsel Mr. Rishikesh Rajan appears on behalf of the Authority. The respondent is absent.
- 2. Learned legal counsel of RERA informs that there is no sufficient evidence available on record to persist with this proceeding for the project -Sushila Mansion and Kamini centre.
- 3. Perused the record. As per the documents available on record Sushila Mansion has only six flats and a total area of 354.22 sq. meter. Another project of the promoter, namely, Kamini centre was completed in 2013.
- 4. In the light of the same, the proceedings pertaining to Sushila Mansion and Kamini Centre may be dropped.
- 5. However, the projects, namely, Awadh Mansion, Ashiana Awadh Manion, Shanti Kashi Mansion and Kamini City ought to be pursued for violation of Section 3 of the RERA Act.
- 6. Learned Legal counsel of RERA is directed to substantiate these cases in separate proceedings for a better appreciation.

7. Let these four proceedings be numbered separately and the instant case No. RERA/SM/394/2019 be dropped for both the projects, namely, Sushila Mansion and Kamini Centre.
