I.G., Registration is also requested to get details of the project verified from the concerned District Sub Registrar who after verification will submit a certificate that there has been no registration in favour of any buyer regarding any flat/ shop/ part of the building thereof pertaining to the present project. Apart from the C.A. certificate, the certificate from the concerned District Sub Registrar should also be obtained in order to prove the fact that there has been no sale of any property or part thereof pertaining to the present project in question.
