03.07.2024 Hearing taken up. Mr. Punit Kumar, Advocate, appears for the complainant. Mr. Mohit Raj, Advocate, appears for the respondent.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant booked Flat No. 101 of 1300 sq. ft. on the 1st floor on 30.05.2015 for a consideration amount of Rs. 25,44,000/-, out of which he paid Rs. 7,51,000/- through various cheques. However, despite the initial payment of more than 10% of the consideration money, the respondent has not executed an Agreement for Sale. The respondent has issued only the KYC to the complainant, which is kept on the record. He also submits that when the respondent did not execute the Agreement for Sale, the complainant sent a Legal Notice dated 17.08.2023 to the respondent, but to date, the respondent has not responded.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the complainant had booked the flat under a One Time Scheme and, since the payment was not made as per the schedule, the complainant's booking has been cancelled. However, he requests four weeks' time to file a counter reply, which is allowed. The respondent's counsel is directed to file a counter reply within four weeks, with a copy to the complainant, who will file a rejoinder within two weeks thereafter.

Let this case be transferred to the Single Bench Mr. S.D. Jha.
