Mr. Manish Kumar Verma, husband of the executant, is present, but learned counsel Ms. Kriti Suman on behalf of the respondent appears through virtual mode.

Husband of the executant submits that neither the respondent is making compliance of the order dated 23.01.2024 passed by the then Hon'ble Member Sri S.D.Jha in RERA/CC/436/2023 nor is physically appearing before the Bench. So, coercive step against the Director of the respondent – company may be taken, whereon learned counsel for the respondent submits that in next week the principal amount will be refunded to the executant.
