- 1. Hearing taken up. Learned counsel Mr. Kishore Kunal appears on behalf of the complainant. Learned counsel Mr. Hemant Kumar appears on behalf of the respondent.
- 2. Learned counsel for the respondent seeks time to file his reply, as the matter put forth during conciliation proceedings would need to be further substantiated.
